- Allow Concrete Mortar Dissolver to penetrate for 10 15 minutes. Then
  re-apply to the same area. Keep surface wet with Concrete Mortar Dissolver.
  Concrete will begin to soften and release from surface. (Total time
  approximately 20 30 minutes).
- 4. Rinse with cold water using a garden hose with a pressure nozzle, or use a high pressure washer.
- On extra thick build up, repeat cleaning directions until build up has softened.
